Our students are certainly enjoying their sports options this term which have included Senior Triathlon, touch rugby, cricket coaching and swimming for different groups across the school. Tomorrow is Hārewa Athletics day, so there has been plenty to keep the children active as part of their personal “wellbeing”.

Today we have hosted the Leadership Team from Mornington School who came to explore learner agency across our school. Feedback from the group was that a strong “culture of learning” was evident across the school and that students were very settled and engaged. They loved the physical environment teachers have developed for their classes, with lots of “learning walls” and prompts for what we expect of our students both as learners and as leaders.

END OF YEAR REPORTING & STUDENT PROFILES

Testing processes for end of year reporting and student profiles have commenced in classes, as teachers begin to gather and collate student progress and achievement information in reading, writing and mathematics. This information, along with ongoing observations of children's learning, is used to make an OTJ (overall teacher judgement) of each child's achievement which is reported in their student profile. This is a very busy time for teachers and it is important that students maintain their focus on learning, to ensure they achieve their best possible results in assessments over the next few weeks.

CLASSES FOR 2022

The composition of classes each year is given careful consideration by both the Senior Leadership Team and classroom teachers with social factors including relationships with other children being considered when there is a choice of classes. In every class, either composite or straight year level, there is a range of academic achievement. We also consider gender balance in each class, but ultimately this is dependent on how many boys and girls we actually have at each year level. Sometimes there is quite a difference between these numbers. We work to ensure there are groups of children working at a similar level within each class, but academic ability is not a major factor when we are making decisions about classes. Most of our classes will be composite classes (two year levels combined) which is the norm in most schools and allows for greater flexibility of placement.

TRANSITION TO COLLEGE PROCESS

This year our Year 6 children will hear from Year 7 college students about life at college. Our students will have a chance to ask Year 7 students questions they have and to hear about their experiences of life as a Year 7 at college. Our Year 6 students will visit college on Friday 26th November. Ako Hub teachers will also meet with the Dean of Year 7 to discuss class placements for 2022.

GAME TIME IN AKO 1!

Ako 1 have been learning Kī-o-rahi, the fast-paced game incorporating skills similar to rugby, netball, rippa and touch, with Mrs Egerton over the last few

weeks. It has been a great opportunity to incorporate their Māori language and love of the outdoors into their learning. We can't wait to see them teach everyone else!




